I am Nancy and I want you to read this completely. It is how Jesus Christ changed my life and eternity completely. I was raised Christian, but it never 'took'. Graduating high school in the 60's, I couldn't wait to flee the nest and make my own mark.

I made so many foolish, dangerous, and selfish choices in my life and pushed Christ away so many times, even though He kept loving me and calling me.
